We try to share and disseminate the multiculturalism in our country, thus supporting the life projects and work of these people, and by improving the degree of closeness and understanding between them.

descriptive memory

The invisibility of immigrant women artists within the art circuit is almost a truism, however it is an issue

that has had very little attention from the "official culture".

The concern over this issue arose out of the necessity to give a voice to immigrant women artists within the

Spanish culture. In order to do this, it is necessary to enter their life stories, to let their vital experiences

function as a mirror game, so that each reflection glimpse the path of an artist: their creative work,

adaptation (or not) to other customs, meetings with their fellow countrymen; sometimes, the natives'

contempt or the stumbled integration; always, the pervasive sense of rootlessness; and at the same time the

illusion of a new life.

The movie "The Waiting" is not intended as a common denominator to understand "what it means to be an

immigrant woman", but to accommodate a series of concrete expressions about women that reflect about

their cultural heritage through art and visual media, to contrast these with that of other women, other men,

other people and thus enrich themselves with everyday knowledge. They seek, through the artistic fact, their

particularly diaspora space, where they can survive.

Approaching the art produced by women of different nationalities, we can go beyond the absorbed

prejudices, on both the art of other cultures and on their ways of behavior.

Patricia Venti holds a PhD Spanish Language and Literature Studies and completed Cinema Studies in Madrid. From 2007 has been involved in different cinematographic projects. For five years she worked as a teacher applying her method at the Exploratory Center for Flamenco Art and Dance in Novi Sad (Serbia), at the Flamenco Association of Pécs (Hungary) and at the Octopont Dance Academy (Budapest, Hungary). She is founder and director of the company "Our Air" (2007-2010) where she participates as a choreographer, dancer, singer and composer. Mariella Köhn

Mariella Köhn was born in Lima-Peru in a family closely linked to music. Her first album was released in 1993 and it was Merengue album. It was recorded in the Dominican Republic with Juan Luis Guerra's producer.

In early 1999 she brought together a group of excellent Latin-American musicians and created QUITIPL®S. With this group she develops musically all the richness of black-culture sounds, extinct in some countries but alive in others, to recover songs, cries and tools, and to find the similarity and joy of Latin American black people.



Mariella has been living in Madrid for 2D years and in 2001 she was appointed Academic of Music, as a member of number, by the Academy of Sciences and Arts of Music from Spain. Her outreach work has led her to present her performance Mariella Sings and Tells around the world, where she shows the evolution of music and life of black-people in Latin America, from colonial times to the present day, on a tour of the different styles of Afro-Peruvian music.

Two years ago the record 'Sí canto landó'was released, which provided new features such as the merger of Landó and Tanguillo Flamenco and rescued the sounds of antiphonal singing and major African percussion. Teaches musicology at the University Complutense of Madrid, being her show 'Mariella Tells and Sings'the area where she combines her vocations of research, teaching and singing.

Nina is Finnish and she studied performance in Helsinki. In 2004, with an ERASMUS grant, she studied Gesture Performance at the RESAD. Since then she lives and works as an actress in Madrid.

During the past two years, wanting to expand her acting training, she participated in several on-camera performance courses. Likewise, she also has in hand a new production: "Gabriel Returns", a Finnish play by Mika Waltaren, in which she will be the main character.
